Dear American visitors,

You have probably heard in the media that your trip to France was questioned due to new European directives. We confirm that France has not taken any new position on the subject and that the United States is still on the green list.

1. You are already vaccinated

You must present proof of vaccination status and a sworn statement attesting to the absence of symptoms of covid-19 infection and contact with a confirmed case of covid-19.

2. You are not vaccinated

You must present to the transport company and border control authorities a certificate of recovery older than eleven days and less than six months or a negative PCR or antigen test not older than 72 hours before departure (departure of first flight in the event of a connecting flights).
